



Architects are using metal in more diverse ways than ever before. Because of the intricate details that are created, the erector, now more than ever, must know and understand the nuances of the system he is installing. As architectural designs become more intricate, so does the installation. To ensure their designs and specifications are complied with, architects are specifying that the roof installer be "certified" by the

NCI believes that manufacturers and installers should be working in cooperation with each other to deliver an "in place" product that meets the customer's needs and expectations. However, this requires that the roof system manufacturer do more than just mail out certificates. NCI is committed to training and educating erectors in both the proper use and installation of our roof systems.











Why Does NCI Have An Installer Certification Program?

- · Architects are demanding it.
- The installation of NCI's architectural roof and wall systems will be improved with greater industry installation knowledge.
- Architectural roof and wall systems offer building owners benefits that no other construction material can offer, but for those benefits to be fully realized, the products must be installed properly. Therefore, the installers should be trained in the proper methods and procedures of installation.

Who Can Be Certified?

Any company/individual combination that meets the requirements.

What Are The Requirements To Be Considered For Certification?

- Three years metal roof & wall installation experience immediately preceding application submittal.
- General Liability Certification of Insurance demonstrating coverage in the minimum amount of \$250,000 for each loss.
- Worker's Compensation Insurance for Applicant and/or Employer or Sponsor Company.
- Neither Applicant nor Applicant/Sponsor has filed a petition seeking relief under the Bankruptcy Code.
- Each Applicant (individual) must submit five references of recently completed projects.

Why Do We Not Certify Individuals By Themselves?

NCI has worked hard to earn the respect of the architectural community and we believe the architectural community wants, deserves and is mandating an authorization program that has depth and substance. This mandate calls for more than individual authorization; it calls for an individual that is backed by an organization (a company) and a support system (a company).

Why Do We Not Certify Companies By Themselves?

We want to make sure the person (the installer) that satisfactorily completes the NCI training is actually on the job supervising the installation.

Which NCI products are included in the certification program?

What Does The Training Class Include?

- Each product class will last a maximum of three days.
- Classroom instruction which includes review of the respective product's technical manual.
- Hands-on instruction which includes review of the respective product's mock-up details.
- Written tests that must be passed.
- Open discussion.
- Upon satisfactory compliance with and completion of the training course, the certificate will be issued and mailed to the installer.

How Much Does The Course Cost?

Each course is \$275.00 per product for the first applicant; \$225.00 per product for the second applicant; and \$150.00 per product for each additional applicant.

How Long Does A Certification For A Product Last?

The certification will expire five (5) years after issuance. After five (5) years, assuming there are no major product changes, the certificate may be renewed for an additional five (5) year period for a \$50.00 fee per certificate, subject to the original terms.

The Installer And The Company Shall:

- Ensure the installer is present on each job site to supervise the entire installation of NCI products.
- Utilize only those methods and procedures demonstrated by NCI at its training seminar.
- Maintain Worker's Compensation Insurance.
- Maintain General Liability coverage in the minimum amount of \$250,000 for each loss, submitted annually.
- Have no claims pending or asserted for negligent or defective workmanship of the respective certified NCI product(s).
- Not file for protection from creditors under any state insolvency or debtor relief statutes or under the United States Bankruptcy Code.

What Benefits Can The Erector Derive From Product Certification?

NCI is seeing more and more architectural specifications requiring the installer to be certified by the manufacturer. Often times the architect requires a list from NCI for certified erectors within the vicinity of the job site. NCI can only send certified installers to the architects. Also, each manufacturer's roof system is slightly different. Training to ensure a properly installed roof is well worth the time invested for certification.

What If There Are Major Product Changes?

Major product changes will require the installer to take a new course. A class will be scheduled and all currently certified installers of that product will be notified of the class date. There will be no charge for this class. However if you do not attend this class and decide to attend a class at a later date, there will be a \$150.00 charge.

How do I enroll?

Complete application for authorized installer certification program and submit with payment and required supportive documentation. Reference online certification checklist for details. Attendees are responsible for own travel/lodging expenses. Lunch to be provided during class.

What if I don't meet all of the requirements to become a certified installer?

You can still attend class for educational reasons to learn the products. On your application, note that you wish to audit the class only. A \$50.00 registration fee is required, which can be applied toward future certification.

What If The Installer Switches Companies?

The new company must fill out an application and meet the listed requirements. There will be \$150.00 transfer charge.


Can A Certification Be Revoked?

Yes. If a certified installer demonstrates an inability to properly install the roof system, refuses to make repairs requested by NCI pursuant to the issuance of a weathertightness warranty, or does not meet the terms of the program, NCI may revoke the installer's certification.
